1. Individual Membership

Individuals who hold a recognised formal qualification in medicine, psychology, social sciences or nursing, or other individuals with professional equivalence, who are or have been actively engaged in research or clinical work with people who have palliative and or end of life care needs and who have paid the annual subscription as laid down by the Executive Committee.

1.2 Individual Members Shall Pay Membership Fees as per the Table.

Individual members shall have the right to vote on International Collaborative business and shall be eligible for election to office in the International Collaborative.
